Key Activities

- Helping at Healthwatch Shropshire run events
- Giving talks to local groups about Healthwatch Shropshire (with appropriate support and training)
- Supporting delivery of Healthwatch Shropshire surveys and projects
- Acting as an ambassador for Healthwatch Shropshire
