Do you care for a friend or a loved one?

Healthwatch Shropshire would like to hear from carers of all ages about their experience of accessing and using health and social care services in the county. Some people do not think of themselves as a carer and yet it includes anyone who cares, unpaid, for a friend or family member with long-term physical or mental ill health, a disability or problems related to old age.

There are currently estimated to be over 54,000 people in Shropshire providing unpaid care for a family member or friend on a daily basis. These people would be unable to cope without that carer's support. That support in turn saves the NHS and social care services millions of pounds every year.

However, the impact of this role on both the carer's physical and mental health is often overlooked.

Jane Randall-Smith, Chief Officer of Healthwatch Shropshire, said: "Making sure you look after yourself is vitally important and knowing where to get the help and support you need to maintain your own health and wellbeing is crucial. We would like to hear if you know where to find help and what you think about the support you get."
