- Promote Healthwatch Shropshire events and projects locally
- Contribute to help develop Healthwatch marketing items, including leaflets and press releases.
- Involvement in social media outreach
- Acting as an ambassador for Healthwatch Shropshire

- Encourage individuals to become members of Healthwatch Shropshire

Time Commitment

This role will require a commitment to giving a few hours a month to ensure that local facilities are stocked with relevant. This role would benefit an individual who is looking for flexible volunteering opportunities. You can do as much or as little as you like.

There may be some periods that are busier than others, and the time commitment can vary depending on other opportunities you may choose to get involved in.

Training and Support

Volunteers receive a full induction to the organisation and role. A full training package is provided to support in conducting the role, with additional training opportunities made available throughout the year.

Quarterly volunteer meetings are held to share learning amongst the volunteer team.
